

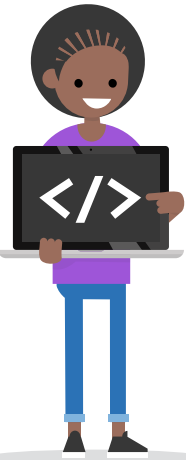
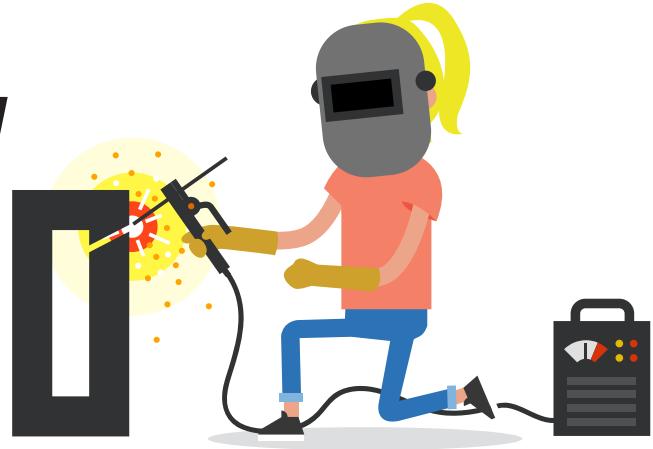
Breaking Traditions

We Weld, We Code, We STEM

June 4–7 and 11–14 | 9 a.m.–2:30 p.m.

Two-week camp exploring careers in welding, coding and science, technology, engineering and math.

- Students will learn the basics of **welding** and leave with completed projects.
- Students will learn computer **coding** and will build games and leave with flash drives that have their completed work on them to play at home.
- Students will work through a CSI using STEM concepts/fingerprinting, blood spatter and DNA analysis and leave DNA necklaces.
- Students will access interest inventory/career exploration across all careers and have planning time for the next steps in their futures.
- Students will not have to pay for the camp.



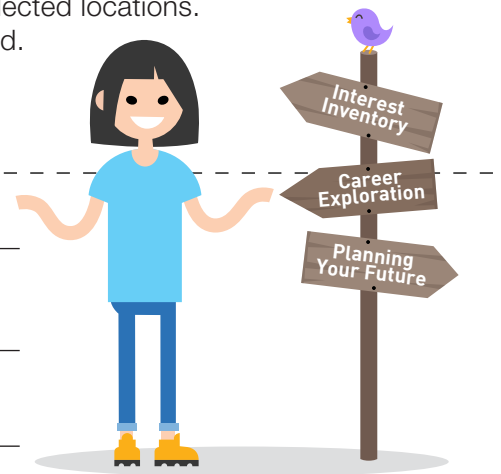
Parent and student acknowledgment of WWTC internet policy is required to attend the camp because students will have access to the WWTC network.

Students will be selected from those who have completed the 7th grade and are going into the 8th grade.

Only 50 students will be accepted on a first-come, first-service basis. The first five students to respond from each school will be selected. Should fewer than five respond from any school before the cut-off date, the remaining positions will be filled on a first-come basis by students from other schools. Buses will pick up and return students to selected locations. Lunch will be provided.
